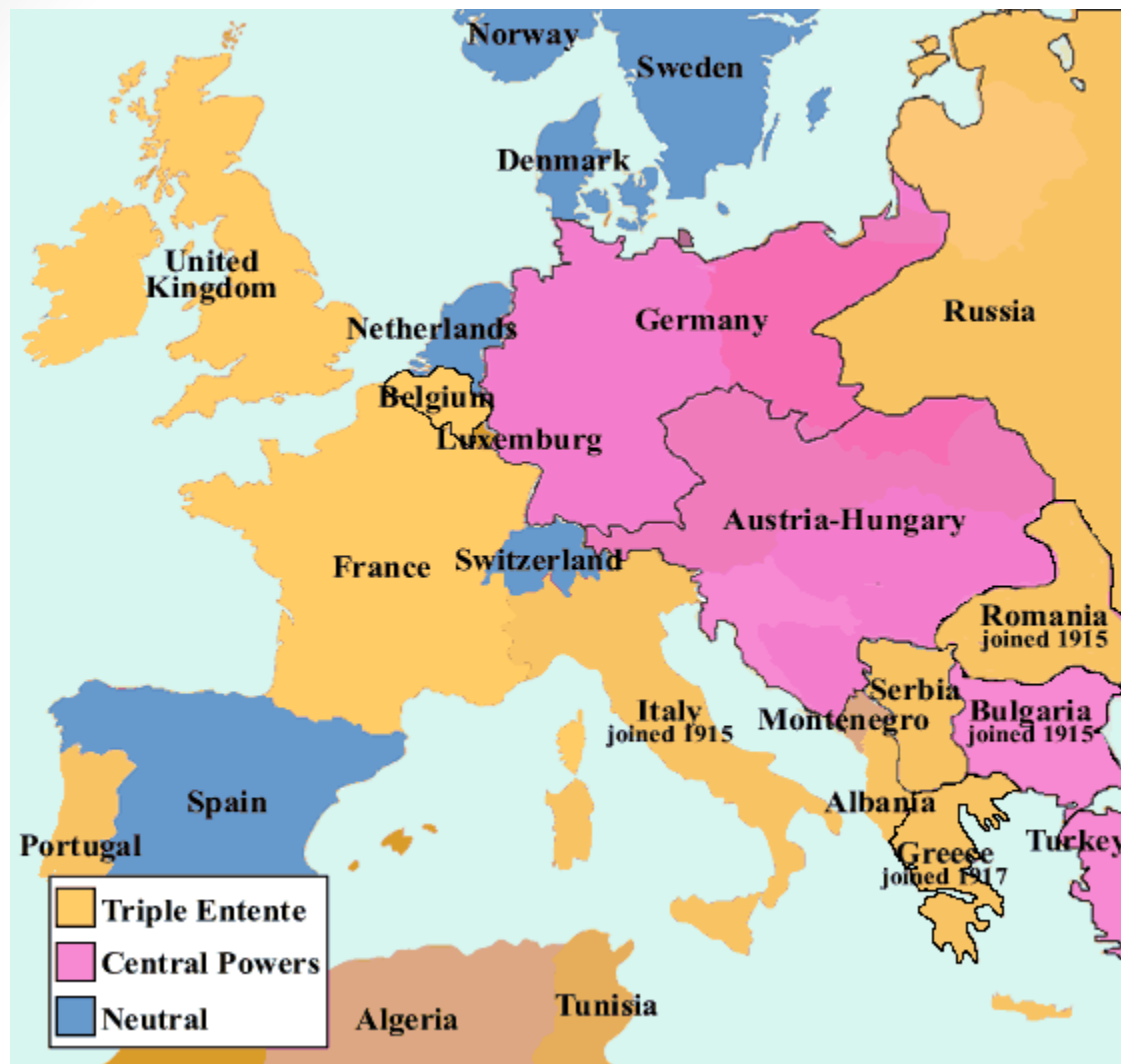

Assassination of Archduke, June 28, 1914

By July 30, 1914 all Europe at war

US remains neutral



Wilson wins Re-election 1916 – vows to keep US out of WWI

Home Front

- Industry and agricultural production controlled by government – curtailed capitalism
- Espionage Act of 1917- goal was to quash acts of treason – monitored mail and expressions of opposition to war
- Sedition Act of 1918- made unlawful to use “disloyal” language about the government, constitution or military forces

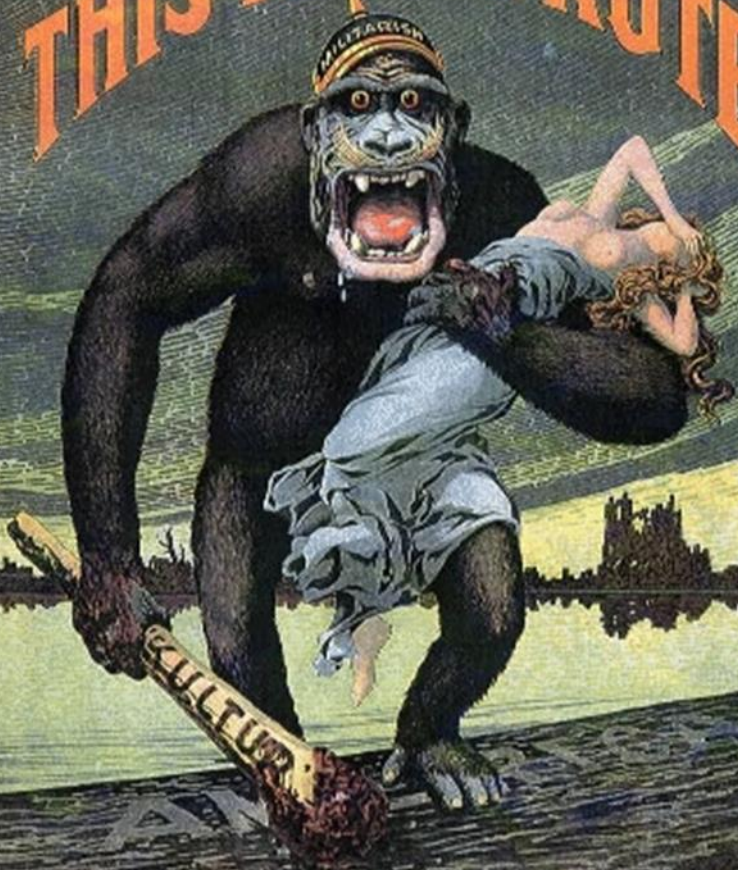

Left Side – Process Page
